Hillsborough County Public Schools (HCPS) is offering the Parent School Partnership Program (PSP) to empower parents to be advocates and leaders in their schools and to build authentic parent school partnerships.

The PSP Program grew out of need to address the educational inequities faced by the Hispanic community. Today the program is offered in English and other languages.

The PSP Program equips and empowers parents through a 12-week leadership seminar to gain the knowledge to:

- ♦ participate in their children's education by learning to navigate the educational system
- ♦ effectively communicate and overcome language or other barriers and capitalize on individual cultural assets
- ♦ gain an in-depth understanding of their parental rights and responsibilities
